### Rebecca Gray


#### Counsellor, Assiniboine College

**Restitution I - Intro to Restitution Self Discipline**

Restitution is a philosophy created by Diane Gossen, based on the work of William Glasser's Control Theory and the principles of Aboriginal Restorative Justice. It provides those working with children hands-on skills to deal with difficult behaviour. Instead of rewards and punishment Restitution focuses on helping students become the person they want to be. Drawing from current research on brain functioning, Restitution recognizes that for true learning to occur, the process that children must engage in is an internal one. Restitution teaches youth self-discipline and skills needed to promote independence, critical thinking and acceptance of personal responsibility for one's actions.
